What books count?

Fiction or nonfiction, biographies or memoirs of Maine people, books about Wabanaki people and culture, books about a traditional Maine industry such as maple sugaring or logging, historical art or architecture in Maine, a book by a vintage Maine author, etc.

Activities

Do 5 activities having to do with Maine history.
Visit a historic site or local monument, attend a event on Maine history, make a craft about a historical topic, watch a Maine historic film, write a review of one of the books you read, or come up with your own ideas.
