
Carver Memorial Library (Hard)

Tudor Revival (1900-present)

- Decorative half timbering
- used in conjunction with other materials
- · Cross gables

Dedicated on October 13, 1910, the Carver Memorial Library was designed by the Boston firm McLean and Wright and donated to the Town of Searsport in memory of George Albert Carver.



Instructions:

- 1. Color the building & add festive decorations
- 2. Cut out along the outside black lines, dotted black lines, ξ areas shaded gray
- 3. Fold along the gray lines. Mountain Fold solid gray lines, valley fold dotted gray lines. Accordion-fold the stairs.
- 4. Secure into a building shape by gluing the flaps to the back of the walls.
- 5. Insert and glue gables into Slots A and B. Glue stairs under doors.
