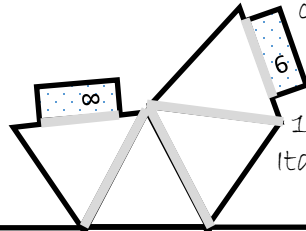


Searsport Methodist Church (Medium)

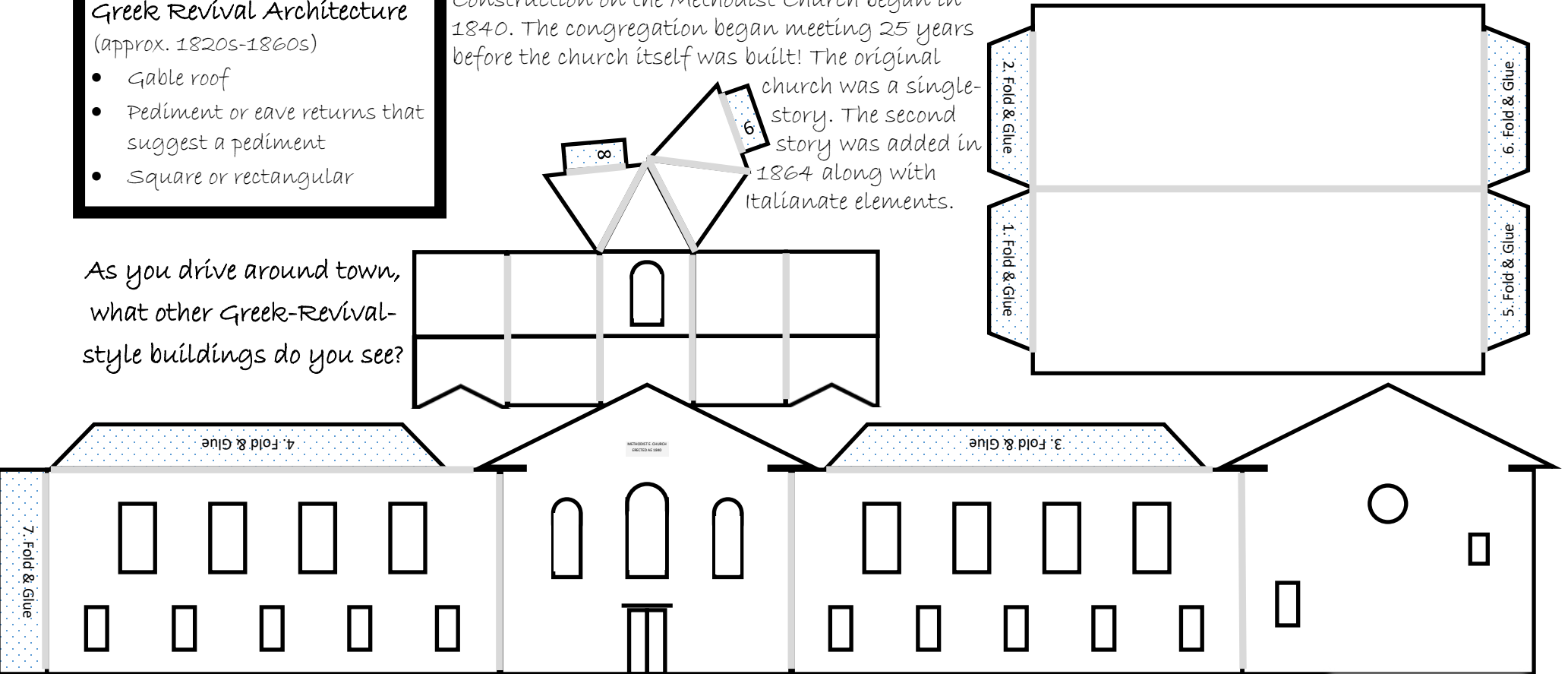
Greek Revival Architecture (approx. 1820s-1860s)

- Gable roof
- Pediment or eave returns that suggest a pediment
- Square or rectangular

Construction on the Methodist Church began in 1840. The congregation began meeting 25 years before the church itself was built! The original church was a single-story. The second story was added in 1864 along with Italianate elements.



As you drive around town, what other Greek-Revival-style buildings do you see?



Instructions:

1. Color the building & add festive decorations
2. Cut out along the outside black lines
3. Fold along the gray lines
4. Secure into a building shape by gluing the flaps to the back of the walls.

Optional: In step 2, cut out the windows. When you're done, add a battery-powered tea light inside the building!
